1. The Arrest

• The problem was not that they were proclaiming the resurrection of Jesus, but proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection of the dead

2. The Charges

- The Roman authorities getting involved was what they were wanting to avoid
- Luke 12:11-12
- It's not about the healing, it's about the salvation

3. The Verdict

• This was not a clear cut case, they really had no charge against them

4. The Result

- Everything that they said to God was shaped by what God had said to them in Scripture
- Notice the filling of the Spirit did NOT result in tongues talking but speaking the Word of God

The real question isn't would you be willing to spend a night in jail for Jesus, but how many nights?
