- His suffering would be so severe He would be unrecognizable
- Acts 8:34-35

He's a Sorrowing Servant

• This man is not what one would expect

He's a Smitten Servant

- The innocent Servant is dying as a sacrifice for our sin
- 1 Peter 2:24

He's a Silent Servant

- 1 Peter 2:21-24
- Ultimately only a person can substitute for another person
- Mark 14:65
- Matthew 27:57-59

He's a Satisfying Servant

- The Servant's sacrifice satisfied God's wrath
- The substance of His reward is the mass of people He redeemed
