- Ephesians 4:30

that He seals, enlightens, instructs, and guides every born-again person,

• Spiritual truth can only be discerned with the help of the Holy Spirit

and that He is the efficient power for godly living, Christian service, and spiritual worship.

- He works in us to transform us into the image of Christ
